Best Ball Format

- Teams are made up of 4 players. All players in the foursome tee off.
 - The team decides the best ball to play for the next shot
- The rest of the team retrieve their balls and hit their second shot from the ball position chosen.
 - The hole is played out in this fashion
- The foursome must use at least 3 tee shots from each player. (If a team is short a player, each member must use 4 tee shots).

Example

Joe, Fred, Jane and Bill all hit their tee shots.

Joe, Fred and Jane hit their shots into the trees.

Bill's ball is 150 yards down the middle.

Joe, Fred and Jane retrieve their balls and proceed to Bill's ball.

At this point each player hits their ball on to or near the green (Hopefully!)

This time, Fred's ball is closest to the hole.

Joe, Jane and Bill pick up their balls and each plays from Fred's ball. If any of these players hole out at this point, the team score would be 3:

- **Bill's drive – 1 stroke**
- **Fred's second – 1 stroke**
- **Whoever's putt or chip – 1 stroke**
- **Team scores is 3**
